Closed Questions v. Open Questions

Closed questions are those you probably already know the answer to or have a strong sense of the answer to. Closed questions are often posed to lead your partner to the solution or suggestion that you think they should consider. In contrast, open questions are generated from your authentic wonderings and curiosity. In other words, open and honest questions are question that you genuinely don't know the answer to.

Open Question Frames¹

•	What's your hunch about
•	What do you assume to be true about
•	What is the connection between and
•	What is your vision for
•	Talk me through your thinking about
•	How do you make decisions about
•	What is most challenging about this for you?
•	What are you most concerned about here?
